



Modawi WebSigner: Fast, simple signatures via the Internet

Modawi WebSigner integrates your customers, local representatives, or subcontractors into the eANV process (eANV = electronic waste records procedure). Electronic documents prepared by you are simply provided via the Internet and signed by the recipient. The finished documents are automatically returned and processed by Modawi. This includes the updating and provision of the registers. Modawi WebSigner is an add-on module for Modawi.

How does Modawi WebSigner work?

Your customer calls and orders a pickup for his hazardous waste.

You already generate a new consignment note and an e-mail automatically during the telephone conversation. Your customer opens the e-mail and clicks the link in it. He immediately sees the consignment note as prepared for him, that you may still explain on the telephone.

Your customer can then sign the consignment note (as well as handover certificates, records of proper waste management or collective records of proper waste management) immediately, or wait until the actual disposal. Once the disposal process is complete, the consignment note is added to the customer register, and upon request your customer can receive a link to an automatically generated register account.

At a glance

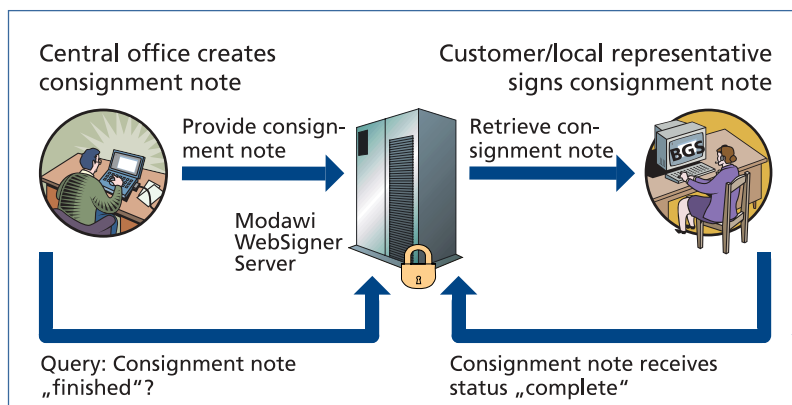
Modawi WebSigner, as a Modawi add-on module, is a Web application enabling signatures in the browser.

Documents are prepared using your own waste management software, and simply provided to customers, local representatives, or subcontractors for signature on the Web. Only precisely defined fields may be changed in the documents by recipients – your data stay consistent.

About Modawi

Modawi handles electronic verification in compliance with the German Ordinance on Waste Recovery and Disposal Records. Modawi provides the functions for the processes of the Electronic Record Procedure including register and signature archival. These functions are used by waste producers, transporters, and disposal companies in their waste management systems.

They thoroughly cover all requirements for electronic verification according to the Ordinance – invisible to the user.

What can you offer with Modawi WebSigner?

The transporter signs ...

- at the producer, though not in the producer's software, but using Modawi WebSigner on a separate PC with Internet access.
- in his own office using Modawi WebSigner, because it's faster, particularly during temporary changes of transport companies.
- for the disposal company at a signature station using Modawi WebSigner.
- on a mobile PC with card reader and UMTS.

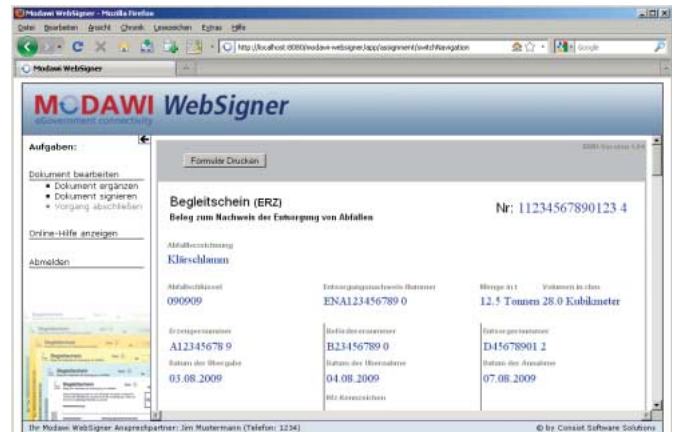
The central office prepares documents ...

- and makes them available to subsidiaries, local representatives, construction sites, etc. for signature using Modawi WebSigner.

After processing ...

- in Modawi WebSigner, documents are automatically stored in the central Modawi system. There is no need to send them.

Modawi WebSigner permits consignment notes to be edited and signed.



What functions does Modawi WebSigner provide in the browser?

- Viewing of consignment notes/handover certificates/records of proper waste management/coll-ective records of proper waste management and register excerpts.
- Editing of the consignment notes in areas predefined by the waste management software.
- Signing of documents in the browser – even signatures by the producer and transporter.
- Printing of documents from the browser (receipt document)
- Login/logout using user ID and password (can be disabled)
